DROAD TRAFFIC

**The A46 and A45 Trunk Roads (Coventry to Kenilworth,
Warwickshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013**

Made - - - - *1st April 2013*
Coming into force - - *8th April 2013*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A46 Trunk Road (“the A46”), the A45 Trunk Road (“the A45”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on lengths of those roads and three of those connecting roads, in the City of Coventry and in the County of Warwickshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A46 and A45 Trunk Roads (Coventry to Kenilworth, Warwickshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 8th April 2013.

2. In this Order:

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| “the first length of trunk road” | means the southbound carriageway of the A46 from its merge with the A444 to its junction with the slip road leading from Stoneleigh Road near Stoneleigh; |
| “the second length of trunk road” | means the southbound carriageway of the A46 from its junction with the slip road leading to Stoneleigh Road near Stoneleigh to its junction with the slip road leading from its roundabout junction with the A452 Leamington Road near Kenilworth; |
| “a slip road” | means – i) the slip road leading to the southbound carriageway of the A46 from its roundabout junction with the A45 and Leaf Lane near Coventry; |

ii) the slip road leading to the southbound carriageway of the A46 from Stoneleigh Road near Stoneleigh; and

iii) the slip road leading from the westbound carriageway of the A45 to its roundabout junction with the A46 and Leaf Lane;

“layby”

means an area of carriageway intended for the waiting of vehicles and bounded partly by a traffic sign of the type shown in diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002(a) and partly by the outer edge of that carriageway on the same side of the road as that on which the sign is placed; and in this definition “carriageway” means any way (other than a cycle track) comprised in a length of the trunk road over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a suitable surface for the exercise of that right;

“the works period”

means the period starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 15th April 2013 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the first length of trunk road, the second length of trunk road or a slip road.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the layby adjacent to the westbound carriageway of the A45 160 metres east of its junction with the slip road leading to the roundabout junction with the A46 and Leaf Lane.

5. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

6. The provisions of article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle-

- (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes,
- (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable, or
- (iii) being used in connection with the said works.
