**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A19 Trunk Road (Holystone Interchange) (Temporary 50 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2013**

*Made* - - - - *11th April 2013*

*Coming into force* - - *21st April 2013*

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A19 Trunk Road and connecting roads, in the District of North Tyneside, is satisfied that traffic on some of those connecting roads should be restricted because of the likelihood of danger to the public while a traffic census is undertaken:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A19 Trunk Road (Holystone Interchange) (Temporary 50 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 21st April 2013.
2. Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this Order, no person shall, during a period of 16 hours starting at 05:00 hours on Monday 22nd April 2013 or any subsequent day thereafter until the likelihood of danger to the public while a traffic census is undertaken has passed, cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour in the A19 Trunk Road northbound or southbound entry slip roads at the A191 Holystone Interchange.
3. The provisions of article 2 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes, or anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable.
4. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(b) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
