**The A303 Trunk Road (Devonshire House to Marsh, Devon)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013**

Made - - - - *7th May 2013*
Coming into force - - *11th May 2013*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A303 Trunk Road (“the A303”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road at Knightshayne Bend in the District of East Devon in the County of Devon should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A303 Trunk Road (Devonshire House to Marsh, Devon) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 11th May 2013.

2. In this Order –

“the A303” means the A303 eastbound and westbound from the centre of its junction with the A30 at Devonshire House to a point adjacent to the tip of the nosing of the eastbound exit slip road at the Marsh Junction;

“tip of the nosing” means the last point where an exit slip road leaves the carriageway of a trunk road;

“the works” mean surfacing and road marking works;

“a works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 13th March 2013 or on any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the A303.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

(a) a vehicle being used for police, traffic officer, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;

(a) 1984 c.27; a new section 14 was substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 (c.26), section 1(1) and Schedule 1.

- (b) anything done at the direction or with the permission of a constable or traffic officer in uniform;
- (c) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (d) vehicles proceeding to or from premises that are accessible from and only from the A303.
