ROAD TRAFFIC

**The M1 Motorway (Junction 9) Northbound Exit Slip Road
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013**

Made - - - - *17th June 2013*

Coming into force - - *24th June 2013*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M1 Motorway (“the M1”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on one of those connecting roads in the County of Hertfordshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M1 Motorway (Junction 9) Northbound Exit Slip Road (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 24th June 2013.

2. Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this Order no person shall, during a period of 9 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 1st July 2013, or on any subsequent day until works to maintain a message sign on an overhead gantry have been completed, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the exit slip road from the northbound carriageway of the M1 at Junction 9.

3. The provisions of article 2 above shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the works or for police, fire and rescue authority, ambulance or traffic officer or purposes.
