

“the slip roads” mean (i) the eastbound and westbound entry slip roads at the A30 Treswithian, Tolvaddon, Avers, Scorrier, Summercourt, Fraddon, Highgate Hill, Victoria, Innis Downs, Bolventor, Cannafraime, Five Lanes, Kennards House and Pennygillam Junctions; (ii) the eastbound entry slip roads at the A30 Mitchell, Callywith, Trebursye and Lifton Junctions; and (iii) the westbound entry slip roads at the A30 Chapel Town, Turfdown and Tavistock Road Junctions;

“tip of the nosing” means the first point where an entry slip road joins the carriageway of a trunk road;

“the works” mean resurfacing, lining, road markings and studding works;

“a works period” means a period of 11 hours starting at 19.00 hours on Monday 22nd July 2013 or on any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 7 and 8, no person shall, during a works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the first length of the A30.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 7 and 8, no person shall, during a works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the second length of the A30.

5. Subject as mentioned in articles 7 and 8, no person shall, during a works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on the third length of the A30.

6. Subject as mentioned in articles 7 and 8, no person shall, during a works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour on the fourth length of the A30 and the slip roads whilst traffic signs of a character authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating “convoy working” on that road are displayed.

7. The provisions of articles 3, 4, 5 and 6 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable.

8. No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
