ROAD TRAFFIC

The A62 Trunk Road (Gildersome) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013

Made - - - - 18th July 2013

Coming into force - - 28th July 2013

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A62 Trunk Road and connecting roads, in the District of Leeds, in the County of West Yorkshire, is satisfied that traffic on that Trunk Road and some of those connecting roads should be prohibited because pavement patching and road marking renewal works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A62 Trunk Road (Gildersome) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 28th July 2013.

2. In this Order; -

“the A62” means the A62 Trunk Road;

“the southbound carriageway” and “the northbound carriageway” mean, respectively, the A62 southbound carriageway and northbound carriageways from its junction with Gildersome south roundabout northwards for a distance of 334 metres

“a slip road” means any of the following slip roads:

- (i) M62 Motorway westbound exit slip road at Junction 27; and
- (ii) M621 Motorway westbound exit slip road at Gildersome;

“the roundabout” means the circulatory carriageway of Gildersome south roundabout;

“the works period” means a period of 9 hours starting at 21:00 hours on Monday 29th July 2013 or any subsequent night thereafter until the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the southbound carriageway, the northbound carriageway, a slip road or the roundabout.

4. The provisions of article 2 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) a vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the said works, or for traffic officer or winter maintenance purposes; or
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform.
