**The A5 Trunk Road (Old Stratford Roundabout,
Northamptonshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order
2013**

Made - - - - *19th July 2013*
Coming into force - - *26th July 2013*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A5 Trunk Road (“the A5”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road, at Old Stratford in the County of Northamptonshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A5 Trunk Road (Old Stratford Roundabout, Northamptonshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 26th July 2013.

2. In this Order:

| “the roundabout” | means the circulatory carriageway of the A5 at its roundabout junction with the A422, A508 and Towcester Road at Old Stratford |
| “the trunk road” | means the section of the roundabout between the slip road leading to the southbound carriageway of the A422 and the slip road leading from the eastbound carriageway of the A5; |
| “the works period” | means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 29th July 2013 and ending when the said works have been completed; |

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle-

- (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- (c) being used in connection with the said works.
