ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A1(M) Motorway (Junction 6 to Junction 7, Hertfordshire)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013**

Made - - - - - *8th July 2013*

Coming into force - - - - - *15th July 2013*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A1(M) Motorway (“the A1(M)”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that motorway and on some of those connecting roads in the County of Hertfordshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A1(M) Motorway (Junction 6 to Junction 7, Hertfordshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 15th July 2013.

2. In this Order –

“tip of the nosing” means, as indicated by the markings on the carriageway, the first point where an entry slip road joins, or the last point where an exit slip road leaves, the carriageway of the motorway;

“the motorway” means the A1(M) –

- (a) northbound carriageway between the tips of the nosings of the exit slip road at Junction 6 and the entry slip road at Junction 7, and
- (b) southbound carriageway between the tips of the nosings of the exit slip road at Junction 7 and the entry slip road at Junction 6;

“a slip road” means the A1(M) –

- (a) northbound entry slip road at Junction 6,
- (b) northbound exit slip road at Junction 7,
- (c) southbound exit slip road at Junction 6, and
- (d) southbound entry slip road at Junction 7;

“works” mean resurfacing, road marking, road stud replacement, loop replacement, grass cutting, verge maintenance, high friction surfacing and kerb replacement and repairs;

(a) 1984 c.27; a new section 14 was substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 (c.26), section 1(1) and Schedule 1.

“a works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 22nd July 2013 or on any subsequent day (other than a Saturday or a Sunday) until the works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the motorway or a slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the works or for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes or proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable.
