

of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a suitable surface for the exercise of that right;

"the works period" means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Saturday 10th August 2013 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding –

- (a) 40 miles per hour on the first length of trunk road; or
- (b) 10 miles per hour on lengths of the second length of trunk road whilst traffic signs of a character authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating “convoy working” on those lengths of road are displayed.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the layby adjacent to the –

- i) eastbound carriageway of the A52 approximately 500 metres east of its junction with Sewstern Lane;
- ii) westbound carriageway of the A52 approximately 554 metres east of its junction with Sewstern Lane; and
- iii) westbound carriageway of the A52 approximately 540 metres east of its junction with Denton Lane.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

6. The provisions of:

- (a) article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle being used for special forces purposes;
- (b) articles 3 and 4 shall not apply to any vehicle -
 - (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes, or
 - (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; and
- (c) article 4 shall not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works.
