**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A2070 and the A20 Trunk Roads (Bad Munstereifel Road)  
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013**

*Made* - - - - - *27th August 2013*

*Coming into force* - - - - - *14th September 2013*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A2070 Trunk Road and the A20 Trunk Road and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on a length of the A2070 and on some of those connecting roads because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A2070 and the A20 Trunk Roads (Bad Munstereifel Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 14th September 2013.

**2.** In this Order:

“the A2070” and “the A20” mean, respectively, the A2070 Trunk Road and the A20 Trunk Road near Ashford in the County of Kent;

“the length of carriageway” means both carriageways of the A2070 between its junction with the A2042 and the roundabout at its junction with the M20 at Junction 10 (A20/A292);

“a slip road” means

- (i) the road leading to the eastbound carriageway of the A2070 from the northbound carriageway of the trunk road at Cloverleaf junction, or
- (ii) the road leading from the westbound carriageway of the A2070 to the southbound carriageway of the trunk road at Cloverleaf junction;

“The Boulevard” means the road known as The Boulevard at its junction with the A2070 at Orbital Park roundabout;

“Waterbrook Avenue” means the road known as Waterbrook Avenue at its junction with the A2070 at Orbital Park roundabout;

“Church Road” means the road known as Church Road at its junction with the westbound carriageway of the A2070;

“Barrey Road” means the road known as Barrey Road at its junction with the eastbound carriageway of the A2070;

“works” mean resurfacing, road marking, stud replacement and all associated carriageway works on the trunk road; and

“a works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 2000 hours on Monday 16th September 2013 or any subsequent day until 13th March 2015.

**3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle –

- (a) to turn right from the westbound carriageway of the A2070 (Bad Munstereifel Road) to Barrey Road;
- (b) to turn right from the eastbound carriageway of the A2070 (Bad Munstereifel Road) to Church Road;
- (c) to turn right from the Londonbound carriageway of the A20 to The Street, the access to and from the A20 (Hythe Road);
- (d) to turn right from the coastbound carriageway of the A20 to Highfield Lane, the access to and from the A20 (Hythe Road); or
- (e) to enter or proceed in the length of carriageway, a slip road, The Boulevard, Waterbrook Avenue, Church Road or Barrey Road.

**4.** The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, fire and rescue authority or traffic officer purposes;
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes; or
- (e) a vehicle proceeding in the length of carriageway to or from premises accessible from, and only from, that road, to such extent as shall be indicated by traffic signs.
