**The A36 Trunk Road (Deptford Junction to Wilton, Salisbury)
(Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) (Number 2)
Order 2013**

Made - - - - *27th August 2013*

Coming into force - - *31st August 2013*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A36 Trunk Road (“the A36”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road between Deptford and Wilton in Wiltshire should be restricted and prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A36 Trunk Road (Deptford Junction to Wilton, Salisbury) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) (Number 2) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 31st August 2013.

2. In this Order –

“the A36” means (i) the A36 eastbound from the tip of the nosing of the eastbound exit slip road at the A303 Deptford Junction to the western edge of Wilton Roundabout, Salisbury; and (ii) the A36 westbound from the western edge of Wilton Roundabout, Salisbury to the tip of the nosing of the westbound exit slip road at the A303 Deptford Junction;

“the tip of the nosing” means the last point where an exit slip road leaves the carriageway of a trunk road;

“the works” mean resurfacing, road marking and drainage repair works;

“a works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 2nd September 2013 or on any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on the A36.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 7, no person shall, during a works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on the A36.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) anything done at the direction or with the permission of a constable.

6. The provisions of article 3 shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works or for traffic officer purposes;
- (b) vehicles proceeding to or from premises that are accessible from and only from the A36.

7. No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
