ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A42 Trunk Road (Ashby-de-la- Zouch to M1 Junction 23a)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013**

Made - - - -21st January 2013

Coming into force - -28th January 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A42 Trunk Road (“the A42”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road and one of those connecting roads in the County of Leicestershire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A42 Trunk Road (Ashby-de-la-Zouch to M1 Junction 23a) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 28th January 2013.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the northbound carriageway of the A42 from its junction with the slip road leading to its roundabout junction with the A511 and A512 at Ashby de la Zouch (Junction 13) to its junction with the slip road leading to the northbound carriageway of the M1 at Junction 23a;

“the slip road” means the slip road leading to the northbound carriageway of the A42 from its roundabout junction with the A511 and A512 at Ashby de la Zouch (Junction 13);

“the works period” means the period starting at 22.00 hours on Saturday 2nd February 2013 and ending when the said works have been completed,

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road or the slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle-

- (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- (c) being used for or in connection with the said works.
