ROAD TRAFFIC

The M1 Motorway (Junction 47, Parlington) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) (No.2) Order 2013

Made - - - - *29th August 2013*

Coming into force - *10th September 2013*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M1 Motorway and connecting roads, in the District of Leeds, in the County of West Yorkshire, is satisfied that traffic on that motorway and one of those connecting roads should be restricted and prohibited because traffic loop reinstallation works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) and regulation 16(2) of the Motorways Traffic (England and Wales) Regulations 1982(b), makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the M1 Motorway (Junction 47, Parlington) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) (No.2) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 10th September 2013.

2. Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this Order, no person shall, during a period of 8 hours starting at 21:00 hours on Wednesday 11th September 2013 or any subsequent night thereafter until the said works have been completed, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the M1 Motorway:

- (i) southbound carriageway from a point 100 metres north of the nose of the southbound exit slip road at Junction 47 (Parlington) southwards for a distance of 800 metres; or
- (ii) southbound exit slip road at Junction 47.

3. The provisions of article 2 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) a vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the said works, or for winter maintenance or traffic officer purposes; or
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform.

4. The provisions of regulations 5 and (in so far as it relates to a vehicle being driven) 9 of the Motorways Traffic (England and Wales) Regulations 1982 are suspended in relation to the hard shoulder adjacent to the M1 Motorway southbound carriageway as described in article 2 at such times and to such extent as may, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs; and in this article "hard shoulder" has the meaning given in regulation 3(1)(e) of those Regulations.
