**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The M1 Motorway (Junction 19, Catthorpe) (Temporary  
Restriction of Traffic) Order 2013**

*Made* - - - - - *19th August 2013*

*Coming into force* - - - - - *26th August 2013*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M1 Motorway (“the M1”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that motorway in the Counties of Leicestershire and Northamptonshire should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the M1 Motorway (Junction 19, Catthorpe) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 26th August 2013.

**2.** In this Order –

“the new Catthorpe Bridge” means the newly constructed overbridge carrying the link road from the southbound carriageway of the M6 to the southbound carriageway of the M1 at M1 Junction 19;

“the motorway” means the northbound and southbound carriageways of the M1 between points 1.5 kilometres south and 1.5 kilometres north of the new Catthorpe Bridge;

“the works period” means the period starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 2nd September 2013 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

**3.** Subject as mentioned in articles 4, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the motorway.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle -

- (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- (iii) being used for special forces purposes.
