ROAD TRAFFIC

**The M57 Motorway (Junction 2 Northbound and Southbound
Exit and Entry Slip Roads) (The Tour of Britain Cycling Event)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013**

Made - - - - *11th September 2013*
Coming into force - - *16th September 2013*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M57 Motorway and slip roads, is satisfied that traffic on four of those slip roads in the District of Knowsley in Merseyside should be prohibited for the purpose of facilitating the holding of a relevant event:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 16A (2)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M57 Motorway (Junction 2 Northbound and Southbound Exit and Entry Slip Roads) (The Tour of Britain Cycling Event) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 16th September 2013.

2. In this Order;

“the motorway” means the M57 Motorway;

“the first slip road” means the exit slip road leading from the northbound carriageway of the motorway at Junction 2;

“the second slip road” means the entry slip road leading to the northbound carriageway of the motorway at Junction 2;

“the third slip road” means the exit slip road leading from the southbound carriageway of the motorway at Junction 2;

“the fourth slip road” means the entry slip road leading to the southbound carriageway of the motorway at Junction 2;

“event” means the Tour of Britain cycling event;

“the event period” means a period between 0000 hours and 2359 hours on Tuesday 17 September 2013, continuing as necessary to facilitate the holding of the event.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order, during the event period, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the first, second, third and fourth slip roads.
4. The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue or ambulance services, or by traffic officers, or to any vehicle proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
