ROAD TRAFFIC

The A5103 Trunk Road (Southbound Entry and Exit Slip Roads to and from the B5167 and the A560) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013

Made - - - - 12th September 2013

Coming into force - - 15th September 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A5103 Trunk Road and its slip roads, is satisfied that traffic on four of those slip roads in the District of Manchester in Greater Manchester should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A5103 Trunk Road (Southbound Entry and Exit Slip Roads to and from the B5167 and the A560) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 15th September 2013.

2. In this Order;

"trunk road" means the A5103 Trunk Road;

"works" means the drainage, gully and associated works on the trunk road;

"the works period" means periods overnights between 2200 hours and 0500 hours during a period starting on Monday 16 September 2013 and ending on Friday 20 December 2013. However, work may start and continue between the same times on subsequent nights or continue until completed, for such period not exceeding 18 months as shall be required to complete the work;

"the first slip road" means the exit slip road leading from the southbound carriageway of the trunk road to B5167 Palatine Road;

"the second slip road" means the entry slip road leading to the southbound carriageway of the trunk road from the B5167 Palatine Road (including the closure of the bus stop);

"the third slip road" means the entry slip road leading to the southbound carriageway of the trunk road from the A560;

"the fourth slip road" means the exit slip road leading from the southbound carriageway of the trunk road from the A560 Altrincham Road.

- 3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the first, second, third and fourth slip roads.
- 4. The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue or ambulance services, vehicles being used in connection with the works, or by traffic officers, or to any vehicle proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
