**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A49 Trunk Road (Bromfield, Shropshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013**

*Made* - - - - *13th September 2013*  
*Coming into force* - - *20th September 2013*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A49 Trunk Road (“the A49”), is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road, at Bromfield in the County of Shropshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A49 Trunk Road (Bromfield, Shropshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 20th September 2013.

2. In this Order:

“layby” means an area of carriageway intended for the waiting of vehicles and bounded partly by a road marking of the type shown in diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002(b) and partly by the outer edge of that carriageway on the same side of the road as that on which the marking is placed; and in this definition “carriageway” means any way (other than a cycle track) comprised in a length of the trunk road over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a suitable surface for the exercise of that right;

“bus stop area” means any area of a carriageway on a side of the trunk road, intended for the waiting of buses, which is comprised within and indicated by a road marking complying with diagram 1025, 1025.1, 1025.3 or 1025.4 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002;

“the works period” means the period starting at 19:00 hours on Monday 23rd September 2013 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

**3.** Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the layby adjacent to the northbound carriageway of the A49 approximately 30 metres east of the bridge over the River Onny at Bromfield.

**4.** Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the bus stop area situated adjacent to –

- i) the southbound carriageway of the A49 approximately 20 metres west of the bridge over the River Onny at Bromfield; and
- ii) the northbound carriageway of the A49 approximately 30 metres east of the bridge over the River Onny at Bromfield.

**5.** The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

**6.** The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall not apply to any vehicle -

- (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes,
- (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable, or
- (iii) being used in connection with the said works.
