ROAD TRAFFIC

The A14 Trunk Road (B1043 Alconbury, Cambridgeshire) Westbound Exit Slip Road (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) (No.2) Order 2013

Made - - - - 30th September 2013

Coming into force - - 7th October 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A14 Trunk Road ("the A14") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on one of those connecting roads in the County of Cambridgeshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A14 Trunk Road (B1043 Alconbury, Cambridgeshire) Westbound Exit Slip Road (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) (No.2) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 7th October 2013.

2. In this Order -

"the slip road" means the exit slip road leading from the westbound carriageway of the A14 to the B1043 at Alconbury;

"works" mean carriageway resurfacing and renewal of road markings and verge, footway, barrier, lighting and drainage maintenance;

"a works period" means a period of 12 hours starting at 19:00 hours on Monday 14th October 2013 or on any subsequent day until the works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4 no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip road.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle
 - (a) being used in connection with the works or for winter maintenance or traffic officer purposes,
 - (b) being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes,
 - (c) proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or traffic officer in uniform, or
 - (d) proceeding to or from properties which are accessible from, and only from, that slip road.
