ROAD TRAFFIC

The A5 Trunk Road (Cannock, Staffordshire) (Temporary 30 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2013

Made - - - - - *27th September 2013*

Coming into force - - - - - *4th October 2013*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A5 Trunk Road (“the A5”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road at Cannock in the County of Staffordshire should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A5 Trunk Road (Cannock, Staffordshire) (Temporary 30 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 4th October 2013.

2. In this Order –

“the trunk road” means the westbound and eastbound carriageway of the A5 between points 750 metres east and 250 metres west of the junction with Four Crosses Lane and Poplar Lane near Cannock.

"the works period" means the period starting at 00:01 hours on Monday 7th October 2013 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5 no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on the trunk road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

5. The provisions of article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle –

- (a) being used for police, fire brigade, ambulance or special forces purposes; or
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable.
