ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A45 Trunk Road (Stonehouse Lane to Tollbar Roundabout,
Coventry) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013**

Made - - - - *4th October 2013*
Coming into force - - *11th October 2013*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A45 Trunk Road (“the A45”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road at Coventry should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) , hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A45 Trunk Road (Stonehouse Lane to Tollbar Roundabout, Coventry) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 11th October 2013.

2. In this Order:

| “pedal cycle” | has the meaning given in regulation 4 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002; |
| “cycle track” | means a way constituting or comprised in a highway, being a way over which the public have the following, but no other, rights of way, that is to say, a right of way on pedal cycles with or without a right of way on foot; |
| “footway” | means a way comprised in a highway which also comprises a carriageway, being a way over which the public have a right of way on foot only; |
| “the footway/cycle track” | means the segregated footway/cycle track adjacent to the eastbound carriageway of the A45 from its junction with Stonehouse Lane to its roundabout junction with the B4110, A46 and Siskin Drive, known as Tollbar End Roundabout; |

“the works period”

means the period starting at 00:01 hours on Monday 14th October 2013 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any person using a pedal cycle to enter or proceed in the footway/cycle track.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any pedestrian to enter or proceed in the footway/cycle track.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

6. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall not apply to any person -

(a) engaged in police, fire brigade or ambulance activity; or

(b) engaged in activity connected with the said works.
