ROAD TRAFFIC

The A5 Trunk Road (Brownhills, Walsall) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013

Made - - - - *4th October 2013*

Coming into force - - *11th October 2013*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A5 Trunk Road (“the A5”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road, near Brownhills in the Metropolitan Borough of Walsall and the County of Staffordshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A5 Trunk Road (Brownhills, Walsall) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 11th October 2013.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the eastbound and westbound carriageways of the A5 between its roundabout junctions with the A452 Chester Road North (Rising Sun Roundabout) and its roundabout junction with the A461 (Muckley Corner Roundabout);

“the central reservation” means that part of the trunk road which separates its eastbound and westbound carriageways for the safety and guidance of vehicular traffic using those roads;

“bus stop area” means any area of a carriageway on a side of the trunk road, intended for the waiting of buses, which is comprised within and indicated by a road marking complying with diagram 1025, 1025.1, 1025.3 or 1025.4 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002;

“the works period” means the period starting at 19:45 hours on Monday 14th October 2013 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 7 and 8, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on the trunk road;

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 7 and 8, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed through any gap in the central reservation of the trunk road;

5. Subject as mentioned in articles 7 and 8, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in any bus stop area adjacent to the trunk road.

6. Subject as mentioned in articles 7 and 8, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or leave the trunk road at its junction with any side road.

7. The provisions of articles 3, 4, 5 and 6 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

8. The provisions of -

(a) articles 3, 4, 5 and 6 shall not apply to any vehicle –

(i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;

(ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or

(iii) being used in connection with the said works; and

(b) article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle proceeding in the trunk road to or from premises which are accessible for that vehicle from, and only from, that road.
