ROAD TRAFFIC

The A184 Trunk Road (Whitemare Pool Interchange) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013

Made - - - - - *24th October 2013*

Coming into force - - - - - *3rd November 2013*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A184 Trunk Road, in the Districts of South Tyneside, is satisfied that traffic on that trunk road should be prohibited because resurfacing works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A184 Trunk Road (Whitemare Pool Interchange) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 3rd November 2013.

2. In this Order:-

“the slip road” means the A184 Trunk Road eastbound entry slip road at Whitemare Pool Interchange;

“bus stop area” means any area of carriageway on a side of the A184 Trunk Road, intended for the waiting of buses, which is comprised within and indicated by a road marking complying with diagrams 1025.1, 1025.3 or 1025.4 in schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(b);

“the first works period” means a period starting 20:00 hours on Monday 4th November 2013 and ending when the said works have been completed;

“the second works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Tuesday 5th November 2013 or any subsequent Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday or Friday night thereafter until the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 5 no person shall, during the second works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip road.

4. Subject as mentioned in article 5 no person shall, during the first works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or wait in a bus stop area situated adjacent to the slip road.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) a vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the said works, or for winter maintenance or traffic officer purposes; or
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform.
