**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The M1 Motorway (Junction 23) (Temporary Restriction  
of Traffic) Order 2013**

*Made*        -   -   -   -        *25th October 2013*

*Coming into force*   -   -        *1st November 2013*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M1 Motorway (“the M1”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of that motorway and one of those connecting near Shepshed in the County of Leicestershire, should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

**1.** This Order may be cited as the M1 Motorway (Junction 23) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 1st November 2013.

**2.** In this Order:

| “the motorway”     | means the northbound carriageway of the M1 from a point 350 metres north of the centreline of Charley Road underbridge to the southern overbridge at Junction 23; |
| “the slip road”    | means the slip leading from the northbound carriageway of the M1 at Junction 23;  |
| “the works period” | means the period starting at 00:01 hours on Monday 4th November 2013 and ending when the said works have been completed;  |

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

**3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the motorway or the slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to any vehicle –

- (a) being used for police, fire brigade, ambulance or special forces purposes; or
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable.
