**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The M1 Motorway (Junction 42, Lofthouse) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) (No.2) Order 2013**

*Made* - - - *31st October 2013*

*Coming into force* - *10th November 2013*

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M1 Motorway and connecting roads, in the District of Leeds, is satisfied that traffic on one of those connecting road should be prohibited because lighting renewal works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order: -

**1.** This Order may be cited as the M1 Motorway (Junction 42, Lofthouse) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) (No.2) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 10th November 2013.

**2.** In this Order “the works period” means a period of:

- (i) 10 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 11th November 2013 or any subsequent Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday night thereafter until the said works have been completed;
- (ii) 11 hours starting at 21:00 hours on Friday 15th November 2013 or any subsequent Friday or Saturday night thereafter until the said works have been completed; or
- (iii) 9 hours starting at 21:00 hours on Sunday 17th November 2013 or any subsequent Sunday night thereafter until the said works have been completed.

**3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the M1 Motorway northbound exit slip road at Junction 42.

**4.** The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) a vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the said works, or for traffic officer or winter maintenance purposes; or
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform.
