ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A1 Trunk Road (North Muskham to Winthorpe,
Nottinghamshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013**

Made - - - - *4th November 2013*

Coming into force - - *11th November 2013*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A1 Trunk Road (“the A1”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road, between North Muskham and Winthorpe, near Newark-on-Trent in the County of Nottinghamshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A1 Trunk Road (North Muskham to Winthorpe, Nottinghamshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 11th November 2013.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the southbound carriageway of the A1 from its junction with the slip road leading from the B6325 Great North Road at North Muskham to its junction with the slip road leading from the roundabout junction of the A46 and A17 at Winthorpe;

“the slip road” means the slip road leading from the roundabout junction of the B6325/Nelson Lane/Bethley Lane at North Muskham;

“the works period” means the period starting at 22:00 hours on Monday 18th November 2013 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle-

- (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- (c) being used in connection with the said works.
