ROAD TRAFFIC

**The M32 Motorway (Junction 1 Northbound Exit Slip Road)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013**

Made - - - - *20th November 2013*

Coming into force - - *23rd November 2013*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M32 Motorway (“the M32”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on one of those connecting roads at Junction 1 in South Gloucestershire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M32 Motorway (Junction 1 Northbound Exit Slip Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 23rd November 2013.

2. In this Order –

“the slip road” means the northbound exit slip road at M32 Junction 1;

“the works” mean resurfacing, lining, studding and traffic loop works and the installation of a new sign;

“a works period” means a period of 8 hours starting at 22.00 hours on Monday 25th November 2013 or on any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, traffic officer, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;

- (c) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works or for winter maintenance purposes.
