**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A27 Trunk Road (Fishbourne Roundabout – Portfield Roundabout) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013**

*Coming into force*   -   -                      *14th December 2013*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A27 Trunk Road and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic should be restricted and prohibited on lengths of that motorway on some of those connecting roads because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A27 Trunk Road (Fishbourne Roundabout – Portfield Roundabout) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 14th December 2013.

2. In this Order:

- “the trunk road” means the A27 Trunk Road near Chichester in the County of West Sussex;
- “the length of carriageway” means both carriageways of the trunk road between Fishbourne roundabout and Portfield roundabout;
- “an access/side road” means any road leading to or from the length of carriageway;
- “works” mean resurfacing, cabling, signing and all associated carriageways works; and
- “a works period” means a period of 9 hours starting at 2000 hours on Monday 16th December 2013 or on any subsequent day until 13th June 2015.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in a section of the length of carriageway or an access/side road.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, fire and rescue authority or traffic officer purposes;
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
