**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A50 Trunk Road (North of Castle Donington,  
Leicestershire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013**

*Made* - - - - 18th November 2013

*Coming into force* - - 25th November 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A50 Trunk Road (“the A50”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road and one of those connecting roads, near Castle Donington in the County of Leicestershire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as The A50 Trunk Road (North of Castle Donington, Leicestershire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 25th November 2013.

2. In this Order:

| “the roundabout”   | means the roundabout junction of London Road, the B6540 Tamworth Road and Trent Lane, north of Castle Donington (Cavendish Bridge Roundabout)  |
| “the trunk road”   | means the eastbound carriageway of the A50 from its junction with the slip road leading to the roundabout to its roundabout junction with the slip roads leading to and from the M1 at junction 24a (Warren Lane Roundabout) |
| “the slip road”    | means the slip road leading to the eastbound carriageway of the A50 from the roundabout;   |
| “the works period” | means the period starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 2nd December 2013 and ending when the said works have been completed;   |

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road, or the slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle –

- (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- (iii) being used in connection with the said works.
