## **ROAD TRAFFIC**

# The A35 Trunk Road (Kingston Ponds Layby, Dorchester) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013

Made - - - - 30th December 2013

Coming into force - - 4th January 2014

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A35 Trunk Road ("the A35"), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road near Dorchester in the District of West Dorset in the County of Dorset should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A35 Trunk Road (Kingston Ponds Layby, Dorchester) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 4th January 2014.

#### 2. In this Order -

"layby" means an area of carriageway intended for the waiting of vehicles, bounded partly by a road marking on the outer edge of that carriageway complying with diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(b); and in this definition "carriageway" means any way (other than a cycle track) comprised in the trunk road over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a surface suitable for the exercise of that right;

"the works" means refurbishment and improvement works;

"the works period" means the period starting at 00.01 hours on Monday 6th January 2014 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter, proceed or remain in the Kingston Ponds layby adjacent to the A35 eastbound situated 1660 metres northeast of the northern edge of Stinsford Roundabout, Dorchester.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:
  - (a) a vehicle being used for police, traffic officer, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;

(b)	anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer
	in uniform;

(c) a vehicle being used for or in connection with the said works.
