ROAD TRAFFIC

The A5 Trunk Road (Atherstone, Warwickshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013

Made - - - - 27th December 2013

Coming into force - - 3rd January 2014

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A5 Trunk Road (“the A5”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on that trunk road and two of those connecting roads, at Atherstone in the County of Warwickshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A5 Trunk Road (Atherstone, Warwickshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 3rd January 2014.

2. In this Order

| “the trunk road” | means – |
| | i) the eastbound and westbound carriageways of the A5 between its roundabout junction with Witherley Road, Harpers Lane and Carlyon Road (Mancetter Roundabout) and its roundabout junction with Spon Lane and Boot Hill (Grendon Roundabout); and |
| | ii) lengths of the circulatory carriageway of the A5 at its roundabout junction with Holly Lane and Merevale Lane (Holly Lane Roundabout) |
| “a slip road” | means the slip road leading – |
| | i) leading from the eastbound carriageway of the A5 to Long Street; and |
| | ii) leading to the westbound carriageway of the A5 from Long Street. |

“the works period”

means the period starting at 21:30 hours on Tuesday 7th January 2014 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road, or a slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle –

- (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- (iii) being used in connection with the said works.
