**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A46 Trunk Road (North East of Newark-on-Trent)  
(Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013**

*Made - - - - 1st March 2013*

*Coming into force - - 8th March 2013*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A46 Trunk Road (“the A46”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road, between Brough and Swinderby in the Counties of Nottinghamshire and Lincolnshire should be restricted and prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A46 Trunk Road (North East of Newark-on-Trent) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 8th March 2013.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the northbound carriageway of the A46 from a point 2700 metres south of its junction with the link road leading to and from Brough Lane at Brough to a point 900 metres north of its junction with Newark Road at Swinderby;

“layby” means an area of carriageway intended for the waiting of vehicles and bounded partly by a traffic sign of the type shown in diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002 (b) and partly by the outer edge of that carriageway on the same side of the road as that on which the sign is placed; and in this definition “carriageway” means any way (other than a cycle track) comprised in a length of the trunk road over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which

has a suitable surface for the exercise of that right;

“the works period”

means the period starting at 06:00 hours on Friday 15th March 2013 and ending when the said works have been completed,

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

**3.** Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the trunk road.

**4.** Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in any layby adjacent to the trunk road.

**5.** The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

**6.** The provisions of:

(a) articles 3 and 4 shall not apply to any vehicle -

(i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes, or

(ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable;

(b) article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle being used for special forces purposes; and

(c) article 4 shall not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works.
