**The Mesothelioma Lump Sum Payments (Conditions
and Amounts) (Amendment) Regulations 2013**

Made - - - - 18th March 2013

Coming into force - - 1st April 2013

The Secretary of State for Work and Pensions makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 46(3) and 53(1)(1) of the Child Maintenance and Other Payments Act 2008(2).

In accordance with section 53(3) of that Act, a draft of this instrument was laid before Parliament and approved by a resolution of each House of Parliament.

Citation, commencement and application

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Mesothelioma Lump Sum Payments (Conditions and Amounts) (Amendment) Regulations 2013 and come into force on 1st April 2013.

(2) Regulation 2(a) applies only in relation to a person—

- (a) first diagnosed with mesothelioma on or after 1st April 2013; or
- (b) where the date of their first diagnosis with mesothelioma is unknown, if a claim is made by that person on or after 1st April 2013.

(3) Regulation 2(b) applies only in relation to the dependant of a person who dies on or after 1st April 2013.

Amendment of the Schedule to the Mesothelioma Lump Sum Payments (Conditions and Amounts) Regulations 2008

2. In the Schedule to the Mesothelioma Lump Sum Payments (Conditions and Amounts) Regulations 2008(3)—

- (a) for Table 1 substitute—
