ROAD TRAFFIC

The A1089 Trunk Road and the A13 Trunk Road (Baker Street Interchange – Marshfoot Interchange) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013

Made - - - - *11th March 2013*

Coming into force - - *30th March 2013*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A13 Trunk Road and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on a length of that road and on some of those connecting roads because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A1089 Trunk Road and the A13 Trunk Road (Baker Street Interchange – Marshfoot Interchange) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 30th March 2013.

2. In this Order:

“the A1089” and “the A13” mean, respectively, the A1089 Trunk Road and the A13 Trunk Road near Grays in the Borough of Thurrock;

“the length of southbound carriageway” means the southbound carriageway of the A1089 (Dock Approach Road) between Baker Street Interchange (A13) and Marshfoot Interchange (A126);

“a link road” means any road leading from the eastbound carriageway or the westbound carriageway of the A13 to the southbound carriageway of the A1089 (Dock Approach Road) at Baker Street Interchange;

“works” mean carriageway resurfacing, bridge joint replacement, road marking and stud reinstatement work on the A13 and the A1089; and

“a works period” means a period of –

- (i) 7½ hours starting at 2200 hours on Thursday 4th April 2013 or on any subsequent day other than a Friday, Saturday or Sunday,
- (ii) 7 hours starting at 2300 hours on Friday 5th April 2013 or on any subsequent Friday,
- (iii) 8 hours starting at 2200 hours on Saturday 6th April 2013 or on any subsequent Saturday, or

(a) 1984 c.27; a new section 14 was substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 (c.26), section 1(1) and Schedule 1.

(iii) 7 hours starting at 2230 hours on Sunday 7th April 2013 or on any subsequent Sunday,
until 29th September 2014.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the length of southbound carriageway or a link road.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, traffic officer or fire and rescue authority purposes;
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
