

**2013 No. 699****ROAD TRAFFIC****The A30 Trunk Road (M25 Junction 13, Link Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013**

*Made* - - - - *11th March 2013*

*Coming into force* - - *2nd April 2013*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A30 Trunk Road and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on one of those connecting roads because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A30 Trunk Road (M25 Junction 13, Link Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 2nd April 2013 and shall apply for a period of twelve months.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A30 Trunk Road at M25 Junction 13 in the County of Surrey;

“the link road” means the dedicated road leading from the westbound carriageway of the trunk road (Staines Bypass) to the southbound carriageway of the trunk road at M25 Junction 13;

“works” mean cyclic maintenance and/or urgent repair work on the trunk road; and

“a works period” means a period of –

- (i) 7 hours starting at 2300 hours on Friday 5th April 2013 or on any subsequent Friday,
- (ii) 8 hours starting at 2200 hours on Saturday 6th April 2013 or on any subsequent Saturday,
- (iii) 7 hours starting at 2230 hours on Sunday 7th April 2013 or on any subsequent Sunday, or
- (iv) 7½ hours starting at 2200 hours on Tuesday 2nd April 2013 or on any subsequent day other than a Friday, Saturday or Sunday,

until Tuesday 1st April 2014.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the link road.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to –

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;

- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, fire and rescue authority or traffic officer purposes;
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
