**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A45 Trunk Road (Ryton-on-Dunsmore, Warwickshire)  
(Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013**

*Made* - - - - *18th February 2013*  
*Coming into force* - - *25th February 2013*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A45 Trunk Road (“the A45”), is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road, at Ryton-on-Dunsmore in the County of Warwickshire, should be restricted and prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A45 Trunk Road (Ryton-on-Dunsmore, Warwickshire) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 25th February 2013.

2. In this Order:

“Ryton Roundabout” means the circulatory carriageway of the A45 at its roundabout junction with the A445 and Wolston Lane, east of Ryton-on-Dunsmore;

“the first length of trunk road” means the eastbound and westbound carriageways of the A45 from Ryton Roundabout to its junction with Brandon Lane, near Ryton Bridge;

“the second length of trunk road” means –

- i) the westbound carriageway of the A45 from Ryton Roundabout to its junction with the slip road leading to its roundabout junction with the A423 Oxford Road; and
- ii) the eastbound carriageway of the A45 from its junction with the slip road

leading to its roundabout junction with the A423 Oxford Road to Ryton Roundabout;

- “the central reservation” means that part of the trunk road which separates its eastbound and westbound carriageways for the safety and guidance of vehicular traffic using those roads;
- “the works period” means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 4th March 2013 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 7 and 8, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on the first length of trunk road.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 7 and 8, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the second length of trunk road.

5. Subject as mentioned in articles 7 and 8, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed through the gap in the central reservation of the A45 approximately 590 metres west of Ryton Roundabout.

6. Subject as mentioned in articles 7 and 8, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or leave the A45 at its junction with High Street, Ryton-on-Dunsmore.

7. The provisions of articles 3, 4, 5 and 6 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

8. The provisions of –

- a) article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle being used for special forces purposes;
- b) articles 3, 4, 5 and 6 shall not apply to any vehicle –
  - i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or
  - ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; and
- c) articles 4, 5 and 6 shall not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works.
