**The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Duxford
Aerodrome) Regulations 2013**

Made - - - 10th January 2013

Coming into force - - 26th May 2013

The Secretary of State deems it necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in the vicinity of Duxford, Cambridgeshire by reason of the holding of flying displays that are scheduled to take place at the aerodrome there on 26th May, 13th and 14th July, 7th and 8th September and 13th October 2013.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 161 of the Air Navigation Order 2009(a).

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Duxford Aerodrome) Regulations 2013 and come into force on 26th May 2013.

Interpretation

2. In regulation 3 all times referred to are Co-ordinated Universal Time.

Restricted airspace

3.—(1) Subject to paragraph (2) between 1200 hours and 1700 hours on each of the following days—

- (a) 26th May 2013,
- (b) 13th and 14th July 2013,
- (c) 7th and 8th September 2013, and
- (d) 13th October 2013,

no aircraft is to fly below 4,500 feet above mean sea level within the area bounded by a circle having a radius of 2.2 nautical miles whose centre is at 520539N 0000753E.

(2) Paragraph (1) does not apply to any aircraft flying with the permission of the flying display director at Duxford Aerodrome.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations impose restrictions on flying in airspace in the vicinity of Duxford, Cambridgeshire, during flying displays that are scheduled to be held at the aerodrome there during various days in 2013.

This event will be open to the general public, and a large number of aircraft will be involved in high-energy manoeuvres during the air show. The Civil Aviation Authority and Department for Transport consider that during the displays, flying should be restricted in the vicinity of Duxford Aerodrome for reasons of public safety.

Full details of the Statutory Instrument will be promulgated by Aeronautical Information Circular and NOTAM.
