**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A12 Trunk Road (Junction 19 Boreham Interchange, Essex)  
Northbound Connecting Roads (Temporary Prohibition of  
Traffic) Order 2013**

*Made* - - - - *4th March 2013*

*Coming into force* - - - *11th March 2013*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A12 Trunk Road (“the A12”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on two of those connecting roads in the County of Essex should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A12 Trunk Road (Junction 19 Boreham Interchange, Essex) Northbound Connecting Roads (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 11th March 2013.

**2.** In this Order –

“the slip road” means the entry slip road leading to the northbound carriageway of the A12 from the A138/A130 roundabout at Junction 19 Boreham Interchange;

“the link road” means the length of road that connects the A138 Chelmer Road with the A12 northbound, at Junction 19 Boreham Interchange;

“works” mean routine inspection works to Generals Lane Bridge;

“a works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 18th March 2013 or on any subsequent day until the works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

**3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4 no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip road or the link road.

**4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to a vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the works or for police, fire and rescue authority, ambulance, traffic officer or winter maintenance purposes, or proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
