**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A41 Trunk Road (Northbound Carriageway between the  
B5133 and the M53 Motorway at Junction 5) (Temporary  
Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013**

*Made* - - - - 29th January 2013

*Coming into force* - - 7th February 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A41 Trunk Road, is satisfied that traffic on a section of that trunk road in Cheshire West and Chester should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A41 Trunk Road (Northbound Carriageway between the B5133 and the M53 Motorway at Junction 5) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 7th February 2013.

2. In this Order:

“the motorway” means the A41 Trunk Road;

“works” means resurfacing works on the trunk road;

“the works period” means three nights between 2200 hours and 0500 hours (continuing to 0700 hours on Saturday and Sunday mornings) during a period starting on Friday 8 February 2013 and ending on Friday 22 February 2013. However, work may start and continue between the same times on subsequent nights or continue until completed, for such period not exceeding 18 months as shall be required to complete the work;

“the length of carriageway” means a section of the northbound carriageway of the trunk road from the centreline of the trunk road with the B5133 to the point where the centrepiece of the trunk road meets the circulatory carriageway of the roundabout at Junction 5 of the M53 Motorway;

3. Subject as mentioned in article 5 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the length of carriageway.

4. Subject as mentioned in article 5 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to turn right from the southbound carriageway of the trunk road into the private access leading to the business premises known as Cropper and Jones Radiator Specialists.
5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 of this Order shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue or ambulance services, vehicles being used in connection with the works, or by traffic officers, or to any vehicle proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
