ROAD TRAFFIC

The M60 Motorway (Junction 7-6 Anticlockwise Collector-Distributor Road and Exit Slip Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014

Made - - - - *3rd April 2014*

Coming into force - - *6th April 2014*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M60 Motorway and its slip and link roads, is satisfied that traffic on one of those slip and on one link roads in the District of Trafford in Greater Manchester should be prohibited and because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M60 Motorway (Junction 7-6 Anticlockwise Collector-Distributor Road and Exit Slip Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 6th April 2014.

2. In this Order:

“the tip of the nosing of the exit slip road” means the last point where the slip road leaves the carriageway of the motorway;

“the tip of the nosing of the entry slip road” means the first point where the slip road joins the carriageway of the motorway;

“the length of slip road” means the tip of the nosing of the exit slip road leading from the anticlockwise carriageway of the M60 Motorway at Junction 7 to the tip of the nosing of the entry slip road at Junction 6;

“the length of carriageway” means the anticlockwise collector-distributor road leading from Junction 7 to a point 1120 metres before where the entry slip road re-joins the main carriageway at Junction 6;

“the works period” means periods overnight between at 2200 hours and 0500 hours starting on Monday 7 April 2014 and ending on Friday 11 April 2014. However, works may start and continue between the same times on subsequent nights or continue overnight until completed, for such period not exceeding 18 months as shall be required to complete the work;

“works” means electrical and routine maintenance works on the motorway;

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to enter or proceed in the length of slip road and the length of link road.

4. The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to a vehicle being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance services or anything done at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
