## ROAD TRAFFIC

## The A590 Trunk Road (Brettargh Holt Roundabout) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2014

 Made
 2nd April 2014

 Coming into force
 22nd April 2014

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport being the traffic authority for the A590 Trunk Road is satisfied that traffic on a section of that trunk road in the District of South Lakeland in the County of Cumbria, should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

- 1. This Order may be cited as the A590 Trunk Road (Brettargh Holt Roundabout) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 22nd April 2014.
- **2.** In this Order:

"the trunk road" means the A590 Trunk Road:

"the length of carriageway" means the northbound carriageway of the trunk road from a point 120 metres south of the centreline of Sedgwick overbridge to the point where the centre point of the trunk road meets the circulatory carriageway of Brettargh Holt Roundabout;

"works" means resurfacing works by Cumbria County Council;

"the works period" means a period starting at 0700 hours on Wednesday 23 April 2014 and ending at 2100 hours on Tuesday 1 July 2014. However, work may start and continue beyond these dates for such period not exceeding 18 months as shall be required to complete the work.

- 3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be driven in the length of carriageway at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour.
- 4. The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to a vehicle being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance services or anything done at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
