**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A628 Trunk Road (Chapel Brow Junction to West Drive Junction) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014**

*Made* - - - - - *10th April 2014*

*Coming into force* - - - - - *21st April 2014*

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A628 Trunk Road, in the County of Derbyshire, is satisfied that traffic on that trunk road should be restricted and prohibited because carriageway resurfacing, cyclic and routine maintenance works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order:

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A628 Trunk Road (Chapel Brow Junction to West Drive Junction) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 21st April 2014.

**2.** In this Order: –

“the A628” means the A628 Trunk Road from a point 100 metres east of Chapel Brow Junction to the centreline of West Drive Junction, a distance of approximately 1200 metres;

“the works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Tuesday 22nd April 2014 or any subsequent night thereafter until the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

**3.** Subject as mentioned in article 5 no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to be driven in the A628 at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour whilst traffic signs of a character authorised under Section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating “convoy working” on that road are displayed.

**4.** Subject as mentioned in article 5 no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to overtake another moving vehicle in the A628.

**5.** The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs. Nothing in article 4 shall apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) a vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the said works, or for traffic officer or winter maintenance purposes; or
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;

and nothing in article 3 shall apply to any vehicle being used for a purpose specified in paragraph (a) of this article.

**6.** No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011<sup>(a)</sup> when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
