**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A43 Trunk Road (Syresham, Northamptonshire) (Slip Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014**

*Made* - - - - *21st April 2014*  
*Coming into force* - - *28th April 2014*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A43 Trunk Road (“the A43”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on one of those connecting roads, near Syresham in the County of Northamptonshire, should be prohibited because of the likelihood of danger to the public:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as The A43 Trunk Road (Syresham, Northamptonshire) (Slip Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on Monday 28th April 2014.
2. Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this order, no person shall, during the period starting at 00:01 hours on Sunday 4th May 2014 and ending when the said likelihood of danger has been avoided by means other than this order, drive any motor vehicle on the slip road leading from the westbound carriageway of the A43 to its junction with an unnamed road leading to Syresham.
3. The provisions of article 2 of this order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes or proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable.
