ROAD TRAFFIC

The M6 Toll Motorway (Junction T3 to M42) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014

Made - - - - 22nd April 2014

Coming into force - - 29th April 2014

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M6 Toll Motorway (“the M6 Toll”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of that motorway and four of those connecting roads, near Curdworth in the North Warwickshire District of the County of Warwickshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M6 Toll Motorway (Junction T3 to M42) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on Tuesday 29th April 2014.

2. In this Order -

“the motorway”

means -

- a) the southbound carriageway of the M6 Toll between its junctions with the slip road leading from Junction T3, M6 Toll, and the southbound carriageway of the M42 (south of Junction 9, M42);
- b) the northbound carriageway of the M6 Toll between its junctions with the northbound carriageway of the M42 (south of Junction 9, M42), and the slip road leading from Junction T3, M6 Toll;

“the slip road”

means the slip roads leading -

- i) to the southbound carriageway of the M6 Toll at Junction T3; and
- ii) from the southbound carriageway of the M6 Toll at Junction T2;
- iii) from the roundabout junction of the A4097 (Kingsbury Road) to the northbound carriageway of the M6 Toll at Junction T1; and

(a) 1984 c.27; a new section 14 was substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 (c.26), section 1(1) and Schedule 1

iv) from the northbound carriageway of the M6 Toll at Junction T3; and

"the works period"

means the period starting at 21:00 hours on Monday 5th May 2014 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the motorway or the slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle -

- (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable, or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (c) being used for or in connection with the said works or by a traffic officer in uniform.
