ROAD TRAFFIC

**The M11 Motorway (Junctions 11 to 14) Northbound
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014**

Made - - - - *6th May 2014*

Coming into force - - - *13th May 2014*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M11 Motorway (“the M11”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that motorway and on some of those connecting roads, in the County of Cambridgeshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M11 Motorway (Junctions 11 to 14) Northbound (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 13th May 2014.

2. In this Order:

“the tip of the nosing” means, as indicated by the markings on the carriageway, the first point where an entry slip road joins, or the last point where an exit slip road leaves, the carriageway of the motorway;

“the motorway” means the northbound carriageway of the M11 from the tip of the nosing of the exit slip road at Junction 11 to the tip of the nosing of the entry slip road at Junction 14;

“a slip road” means the entry slip road to the northbound carriageway of the M11 at Junction 11 and Junction 12;

“works” mean resurfacing, renewal of road marking and road studs and gully cleaning and landscape maintenance;

“a works period” means a period of 7 hours starting at 22:00 hours on Monday 19th May 2014 or on any subsequent day until the works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the motorway or a slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle –

- (a) being used in connection with the works or for traffic officer purposes,
- (b) being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes, or

(c) proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
