**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A64 Trunk Road (Ganton) (Temporary 40 Miles Per Hour  
and 10 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2014**

*Made* - - - 24th April 2014

*Coming into force* - 4th May 2014

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A64 Trunk Road and connecting roads, in the District of Ryedale, in the County of North Yorkshire, is satisfied that traffic on that trunk road should be restricted because carriageway resurfacing, road studding, road marking and verge improvement works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order:

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A64 Trunk Road (Ganton) (Temporary 40 Miles Per Hour and 10 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 4th May 2014.

**2.** Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this Order, no person shall, during a period of 10 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 5th May 2014 or any subsequent night thereafter until the said works have been completed, cause or permit any vehicle to be driven in the A64 eastbound or westbound carriageways from a point 369 metres west of the centreline of Woodside Road Junction to a point 125 metres east of that junction, a distance of 494 metres, at a speed exceeding:

- (i) 10 miles per hour whilst traffic signs of a character authorised under Section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating “convoy working” on that road are displayed; or
- (ii) 40 miles per hour whilst such traffic signs in relation to that road are not displayed.

**3.** The provisions of article 2 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes, or anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable.

**4.** No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(b) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
