**The M56 Motorway (Junctions 6 Westbound Entry Slip Road)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014**

Made - - - - - *29th April 2014*
Coming into force - - - - - *4th May 2014*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M56 Motorway and slip roads, is satisfied that traffic on one of those slip roads in the District of Manchester in the Greater Manchester should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M56 Motorway (Junctions 6 Westbound Entry Slip Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 4th May 2014.

2. In this Order;

“the motorway” means the M56 Motorway;

“works” technology works and routine maintenance works on the slip road;

“the works period” means overnight between 2200 hours and 0500 hours during a period starting on Monday 5 May 2014 and ending on Tuesday 6 May 2014. However, work may start and continue between the same times on subsequent nights or continue until completed, for such period not exceeding 18 months as shall be required to complete the work;

“the slip road” means the entry slip road leading to the westbound carriageway of the motorway at Junction 6;

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue or ambulance services, vehicles being used in connection with the works or being used for winter maintenance purposes, or by traffic officers, or to any vehicle proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
