ROAD TRAFFIC

The M6 Motorway (Junctions 35-36 Northbound Exit Slip Road to Burton-in-Kendal Services) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014

Made - - - - *30th April 2014*
Coming into force - - *18th May 2014*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M6 Motorway and its slip roads, is satisfied that traffic on one of those slip roads in the District of South Lakeland in the County of Cumbria should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as The M6 Motorway (Junctions 35-36 Northbound Exit Slip Road to Burton-in-Kendal Services) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 18th May 2014.

2. In this Order;

“the motorway” means the M6 Motorway between Junctions 35 and 36;

“works” means bridge inspection and survey works on the motorway;

“the works period” means two nights between 2000 hours and 2400 hours starting on Monday 19 May 2014 and ending on Tuesday 20 May 2014. However, work may start and continue between the same times on subsequent nights or continue overnight until completed, for such period not exceeding 18 months as shall be required to complete the work;

“the slip road” means the exit slip road leading from the northbound carriageway of the motorway to Burton-in-Kendal Services.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue or ambulance services, vehicles being used in connection with the works, or by traffic officers, or to any vehicle proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
