**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A34 Trunk Road (Wendlebury) (Closure of Lay-by) Order  
2014**

*Made* - - - - - *19th May 2014*

*Coming into force* - *2nd June 2014*

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 1(1) and 2(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A34 Trunk Road (Wendlebury) (Closure of Lay-by) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 2nd June 2014.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A34 Trunk Road near Wendlebury in the County of Oxfordshire;

“lay-by” means an area of carriageway, intended for the waiting of vehicles and bounded partly by a road marking on the outer edge of that carriageway complying with diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(b).

3. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the lay-by in the northbound carriageway of the trunk road, 500 metres south of the M40 Junction 9 roundabout.

This Order closes the lay-by in the northbound carriageway of the A34 near Wendlebury in the County of Oxfordshire, 500 metres south of the M40 Junction 9 roundabout.
