**The A45 and A423 Trunk Roads (Ryton, Warwickshire)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014**

Made - - - - 6th May 2014

Coming into force - - 13th May 2014

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A45 Trunk Road (“the A45”), and the A423 Trunk Road (“the A423”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of one of those trunk roads and some of those connecting roads, at Ryton in the County of Warwickshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A45 and A423 Trunk Roads (Ryton, Warwickshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on Tuesday 13th May 2014.

2. In this Order:

“Ryton Roundabout” means the circulatory carriageway of the A423 at its junction with the slip roads leading from and to the northbound carriageway of the A45;

“a slip road” means the slip roads leading –

- a) from the northbound carriageway of the A45, to its junction with Ryton Roundabout;
- b) to the northbound carriageway of the A45, from its junction with Ryton Roundabout; and
- c) from the southbound carriageway of the A45, to its junction with Ryton Roundabout;

“the works period” means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 19th May 2014 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in Ryton Roundabout or a slip road.

4. The provisions of articles 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle-

- (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable;
- (c) being used in connection with the said works; or
- (d) proceeding to and from premises which are accessible from, and only from, the trunk road.
