ROAD TRAFFIC

The A50 Trunk Road (Meir to Tean, Staffordshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014

Made - - - - *19th May 2014*

Coming into force - - *26th May 2014*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A50 Trunk Road (“the A50”) and connecting roads is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road and three of those connecting roads, between Meir and Tean in the County of Staffordshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A50 Trunk Road (Meir to Tean, Staffordshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on Monday 26th May 2014.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road”

means –

- a) the westbound carriageway of the A50 from its roundabout junction with the A521 Uttoxeter Road (Tean Roundabout), to its junction with the slip road leading from the A521 Uttoxeter Road and Lysander Road roundabout (Meir Interchange); and
- b) the eastbound carriageway of the A50 from its junction with the slip road leading to the A521 Uttoxeter Road and Lysander road roundabout (Meir Interchange), to its roundabout junction with the A521 Uttoxeter Road (Tean Roundabout);

“a slip road”

means the slip road leading –

- a) to the eastbound carriageway of the A50 from its roundabout junction with the A521 Uttoxeter Road and Lysander Road (Meir Interchange);

(a) 1984 c.27; a new section 14 was substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 (c.26), section 1(1) and Schedule 1.

- b) to the eastbound carriageway of the A50 from its roundabout junction with the B5029 Grindley Lane; and
- c) to the westbound carriageway of the A50 from its roundabout junction with the B5029 Grindley Lane;

“the works period”

means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 2nd June 2014 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road or a slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle-

- (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- (c) being used in connection with the said works.
